The Virtues of Reading the Glorious Qur'an

1. The best among the people are those who learn the Glorious Qur'an and teach it to others. (Content of Hadith)
2. The rust of the heart is removed. (Hadith)
3. It increases the love of Allah ﷻ. (Content of Hadith)
4. One gets ten rewards for reading every single letter even without understanding it. (Hadith)

The Etiquettes of Reading the Glorious Qur'an

A reciter should do the following:

1. Be clean.
2. Be in the state of Wudhu.
3. Sit with great respect while reading the Glorious Qur'an.
4. Place the Glorious Qur'an on a stand or something high.
5. Have a book cover over the Glorious Qur'an.
6. Start the recitation of the Glorious Qur'an with Ta'awwuz and Tasmiyah.
7. Do not indulge in talking while reciting the Glorious Qur'an.
8. If one speaks during the recitation, then resume it with Ta'awwuz only.
9. The reciter should bear in mind that Allah ﷻ is commanding him, "Read! How beautiful you read!"
10. The listener should have in mind that the Glorious words of Allah ﷻ are being read.
11. Read with spiritual submissiveness (khushu) out of respect for the Qur'an.
12. Ask Allah ﷻ for His bounty at the Ayaat of mercy and to seek refuge with Him at the Ayaat of warning.

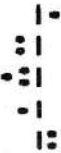

Rules:

1. Fat'hah, Kasrah, and Dhammah are called Harakaat.
2. A letter which has Harakah is called Mutaharrrik.
3. The letters with Fat'hah, Kasrah, and Dhammah should not be stretched and should be read quickly.
4. The sound of Fat'hah goes upwards.
5. Whenever there is a Fat'hah over Alif, it is not called Alif. It is called Hamzah.

Rules:

- There are two ways of reading the letters with Dhammah, i.e. Maroof and Majhool.
Examples of Maroof: Bu (ب) Ju (ج) Su (س) Zu (ز)
Examples of Majhool: Bo (ب) Jo (ج) So (س) Zo (ز)
- The letters with Dhammah should always be read Maroof and should not be read Majhool.
- While pronouncing the letters with Dhammah lips should be shaped round.

Rules:

- There are two ways of reading the letters with Kasrah, i.e. Maroof and Majhool.
Examples of Maroof: Bi (ب) Ji (ج) Si (س) Zi (ز)
Examples of Majhool: Bay (ب) Jay (ج) Say (س) Zay (ز)
- The letters with Kasrah should always be read Maroof and should not be read Majhool.

Rules:

1. When Ya Sakin has Kasrah before it, it is called Ya Maddah.
2. Ya Maddah should always be prolonged for the duration of one Alif (aproxipately one second).

Rules:

1. Three letters Alif, Wau, and Ya (و ي) are called Hurooful-Madd.
2. These letters are considered Hurooful-Madd when:
 - Alif has Fat'hah before it, as Ba Alif Fat'hah Baa — بَا
 - Ya Sakin has Kasrah before it, as Ba Ya Kasrah Bee — بِي
 - Wau Sakin has Dhammah before it, as Ba Wau Dhammah Boo — بُو
3. Hurooful-Madd should be prolonged for the duration of one Alif.
